| 2     | Describe                   | Focus should be only on that particular subject matter (Preface is must but conclusion is your optional)                                     |
| 3     | Explain                    | The answer should be based on answering in detail. Why, How, for what, of that subject of the question.<br>(Preface and conclusion are must) |
| 4     | Distinguish, Differentiate | Answer should be based on How the subject of question differs from other things. (only Preface is must)                                      |
| 5     | Elaborate, Expand          | Elaborate and Expand are the same words and it means detailed explanations   |
| 6     | Examine                    | The answer should consist of the how good, what disadvantages, what impact of the subject of question.                                       |
| 7     | Enumerate                  | First list out the all the relevant points, then explain one by one. (Preface and conclusion are must)                                       |

| 8  | Reason                              | Find out the correct reason for the subject and explain one by one without side heading but highlighting the point with dots or numbers.<br>(only Preface)                            |
| 9  | Analyse                             | Try to give your view with future impact & goods and bads. (both Preface and conclusion are must)   |
| 10 | Elucidate,<br>Exemplify,<br>Clarify | Elucidate means make it clear, so you can give examples in simple language to make it clear. Whenever you give such examples in these categories you have to include current affairs. |
| 11 | Substantiate                        | It requires you to validate the already proven point and not debating between the various points.   |
| 12 | Illustrate                          | It means use examples; data, diagrams and charts to make it clear   |
| 13 | Summarise                           | It means be brief and straight to the point. The key is to get all the main facts across to the reader in a simple manner.  |
| 14 | Compare &<br>Contrast               | You can write similarities as well as differences if it is asking to Compare and Contrast.  |
