The Questions will be of **objective type** with multiple choices and are likely to include questions pertaining to:

**a. Mathematics:** Number System, Decimals, Fractions, LCM, HCF, Ratio and Proportions, Percentage, Mensuration, Time and Work, Time and Distance, Simple and Compound Interest, Profit and Loss, Elementary Algebra, Geometry and Trigonometry, Elementary Statistics etc.

**b. General Intelligence and Reasoning:** Analogies, Completion of Number and Alphabetical Series, Coding and Decoding, Mathematical Operations, Similarities and Differences, Relationships, Analytical Reasoning, Syllogism, Jumbling, Venn Diagrams, Puzzle, Data Sufficiency, Statement- Conclusion, Statement- Courses of Action, Decision Making, Maps, Interpretation of Graphs etc.

**General Awareness:** Current Events of National and International Importance, Games and

Sports, Art and Culture of India, Indian Literature, Monuments and Places of India, General Science and Life Science (up to 10th CBSE), History of India and Freedom Struggle, Physical, Social and Economic Geography of India and World, Indian Polity and Governance- constitution and political system, General Scientific and Technological Developments including Space and Nuclear Program of India, UN and Other important World Organizations, Environmental Issues Concerning India and World at Large, Basics of Computers and Computer Applications, Common Abbreviations, Transport Systems in India, Indian Economy, Famous Personalities of India and World, Flagship Government Programs, Flora and Fauna of India, Important Government and Public Sector Organizations of India etc.

The above-given salary is inclusive of the benefits and allowances provided by the Indian Railways. There are numerous allowances that an RRB Assistant Loco Pilot receives along with the salary. This includes:

1. House Rent Allowance
2. Dearness Allowance
3. Transport Allowance
4. Running Allowance (based on the kilometres travelled)

Apart from this, a 10% deduction from the salary is made as per the new pension scheme.

### **RRB Group D Exam Pattern**

Any changes in the RRB Group D exam pattern is decided or done by the conducting body. The RRB Group D selection process comprises three stages:

1. RRB Group D (CBT) Computer Based Test
2. RRB Group D (PET) Physical Efficiency Test
3. RRB Group D (DV) Document Verification

The computer-based test of RRB Group D exam is conducted for 1 and half hours and asks 100 questions. There is a negative marking scheme in RRB Group D exam. Candidates for each wrong attempt will be penalized with 1/3rd marks.

**RRB Group D PET Exam Pattern** : After successfully clearing the CBT exam i.e. attaining the minimum qualifying marks as set by the board, candidates are called for the PET test, the next round of RRB Group D selection process.

The RRB Group D PET is just qualifying in nature i.e. it is mandatory for candidates to clear the exam but the marks obtained won't be considered for the final selection of candidates.

**The RRB Group D Pay Scale** i.e. the basic salary of candidates selected in RRB Group D recruitment as set by RRB is **rupees 18000/- per month**. The detailed RRB Group D salary structure is given in the table below.
