- **Constitutional Basis:** Established under Articles 315-323, Part XIV, Chapter II of the Indian Constitution.
- **Primary Role:** Conducts various examinations on behalf of the Union government.
- Major Examination: Conducts the Civil Services Examination annually.

- Indian Administrative Service (IAS)
- Indian Foreign Service (IFS)
- Indian Police Service (IPS)
- Central Services Group A and Group B.
