- **Date**: November.
- Participants: 8,000 tea tribe artists.

Jhumur Dance of Assam

- Regions: Assam, West Bengal, Jharkhand, Bihar, Odisha, Chhattisgarh.
- Occasions: Harvest season, Karam Puja, Tushu Puja.

Performance and Movements

- Participants:
 - Young girls (dancers).
 - o Male members (music and vocals).
- Choreography:
 - o Girls hold each other's waists.
 - Synchronized hand and leg movements.
 - Forward and backward steps.
- Musical Accompaniment:
 - o Instruments: Madal, Dhol, Flute, Shehnai, Taal.
- Attire:
 - o Girls: White sarees with red borders.
 - Boys: Long traditional kurtas.

Cultural Significance

- Ritualistic Roles:
 - o Ritual worship, prayer for rainfall, courtship.
- Social Functions:
 - o Expression of community life.
 - Recreation from agricultural work.


Ancient Origins
