WHAT'S IN THE NEWS?

An Indian tourist bus with around 40 passengers plunged into the Marsyangdi River in Nepal's Tanahun district, leading to multiple fatalities and injuries.



Marsyangdi River:

- Origin: Begins at 3,600 meters altitude northwest of the Annapurna massif in Nepal.
- Flow Path:
 - Flows eastward through Manang District.
 - Flows southward through Lamjung District.
 - Joins the Trishuli River near Mugling.
- River System: Part of the Gandaki River system, also known as Narayani.
- Tributaries: Includes Nagdi Khola, Dordi Khola, Chepe Khola, Chundi Khola, and Daraudi.
