## **Bio-RIDE Scheme:**

- Unified Scheme: Merges two DBT umbrella schemes, with a focus on biomanufacturing and biofoundry.
- **Proposed Outlay:** Rs. 9,197 crore for the 15th Finance Commission period (2021-22 to 2025-26).

## **Components:**

- **R&D**: Support for research in healthcare, agriculture, and bioenergy.
- Industrial & Entrepreneurship Development: Seed funding, incubation, and mentorship for bio-entrepreneurs.
- Biomanufacturing & Biofoundry: Sustainable bio-manufacturing aligned with the 'LiFE' initiative.

## **Bio-RIDE**

Cabinet approves 'Biotechnology Research Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development (Bio- RIDE)'



- Bio-RIDE is a merger of Biotechnology Research and Development & Industrial & Entrepreneurship Development (I&ED) of Department of Biotechnology with a new component ie Biomanufacturing and Biofoundry
- Proposed outlay of the unified scheme is Rs.9197 cr from 2021-22 to 2025-26
- Implementation of Bio-RIDE Scheme will

  - Advance Innovation
  - Facilitate Industry-Academia Collaboration
  - Encourage Sustainable Biomanufacturing
  - Support researchers through Extramural funding
