

"THE QUAD: A STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP FOR GLOBAL SECURITY AND COOPERATION" – PAPER II



The Foundation and Objective of the Quad:

The Quadrilateral Security Dialogue, commonly known as the Quad, is a strategic partnership between four prominent democratic nations — India, the United States, Japan, and Australia. Initially conceived in 2007, the Quad was born out of shared concerns about regional security, particularly in the Indo-Pacific region. It was designed to counterbalance growing Chinese influence and ensure peace and stability in an area of strategic importance.

The Quad, though initially met with skepticism and seen by some as a temporary grouping, evolved over time to become a significant player in the international order. It took on greater meaning and commitment in 2017 when the four nations revived the platform amidst increasing tensions in the Indo-Pacific. Since then, the Quad's objectives have grown, not only focusing on security but also addressing a broad range of issues including economic cooperation, technology sharing, and environmental concerns.

At its core, the Quad champions a "free, open, and inclusive Indo-Pacific," emphasizing the rule of law, democratic principles, territorial integrity, sovereignty, and peaceful resolution of disputes.

While it is often seen as a counter to China's assertiveness, the Quad has always emphasized that it is not directed "against" any country but is instead focused on maintaining stability and order in the region.

The Recent Quad Summit:

In the face of growing geopolitical challenges, the sixth Quad Leaders' Summit was held in Delaware, the hometown of US President Joe Biden. This summit took place at a crucial time when global tensions were running high. The leaders of India, the United States, Japan, and Australia met against a backdrop of multiple conflicts, including the ongoing war in Ukraine, rising tensions in Gaza, and most notably, China's assertive behavior in the Indo-Pacific.

The summit's timing and venue were symbolic of the importance that the Quad nations place on maintaining unity and cooperation. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, US President Joe Biden, Japanese Prime Minister Fumio Kishida, and Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese all emphasized the Quad's mission to ensure stability, peace, and economic prosperity in the region, while adhering to a rules-based international order.

The Focus of the Summit:

While the Quad summit addressed various global issues, it was clear that China was the primary point of concern. During the meeting, Biden made candid remarks, picked up by a hot mic, indicating that China was "testing" the Quad members while attempting to "buy diplomatic space" for itself. This assertion was a clear acknowledgment of the challenges posed by Beijing's increasingly aggressive stance in regions like the South China Sea, the East China Sea, South Asia, and the Taiwan Strait.

The Quad's focus on China became even more evident in the official declaration that was adopted after the summit. This declaration explicitly mentioned concerns about "militarization" and "intimidating maneuvers" in the South China Sea. It underscored the Quad's determination to oppose any unilateral actions that seek to change the status quo by force or coercion.

However, the Quad's agenda extended beyond China. The leaders also discussed global conflicts such as the war in Ukraine and the humanitarian crisis in Gaza. The declaration expressed concern

about the negative impacts of the Ukraine conflict on global food and energy security and underscored the urgent need for increased humanitarian aid in Gaza. The Quad leaders emphasized that their grouping was about practical and meaningful outcomes in strategic areas like maritime security, climate change, critical technologies, and economic development.

Key Declarations and Initiatives:

- 1. China and the Indo-Pacific: The declaration took a strong stand on the situation in the Indo-Pacific, particularly focusing on the South China Sea. The Quad members expressed serious concern about the militarization of disputed features and coercive actions in the maritime domain. They reaffirmed their commitment to the principles of territorial integrity, sovereignty, and the peaceful settlement of disputes, condemning the use of force or threats in the region. The mention of the 2016 Arbitral Award, which ruled against China's claims in the South China Sea, was significant, signaling the Quad's support for international law.
- 2. Ukraine and Global Security: The Quad's declaration on Ukraine emphasized the need for a comprehensive, just, and lasting peace, in line with international law and the UN Charter. The leaders noted the terrible humanitarian consequences of the war and reiterated the need to respect sovereignty and territorial integrity. This statement echoed the Quad's broader commitment to global stability and respect for the international order.
- 3. Humanitarian Crisis in Gaza: The declaration condemned the October 7, 2023, terrorist attacks and called for the release of hostages held by Hamas, noting that this could lead to a ceasefire in Gaza. The leaders underscored the urgency of increasing humanitarian aid to Gaza and preventing further regional escalation. This shows that the Quad is concerned with humanitarian issues and crisis management beyond its immediate region.
- 4. Quad Cancer Moonshot Initiative: One of the most impactful initiatives announced during the summit was the Quad Cancer Moonshot. This initiative focuses on combating cervical cancer in the Indo-Pacific region and lays the foundation for future efforts to address other forms of cancer. This health initiative highlights the Quad's broadening agenda beyond military and security concerns, contributing to human development and well-being.
- 5. **Maritime Security and Technology**: The Quad emphasized its commitment to enhancing maritime security in the Indo-Pacific by providing new maritime technologies to regional partners. This included the first-time cooperation between coast guards to enhance monitoring and security in their waters. In addition, the Quad announced the expansion of its



fellowship program to include students from Southeast Asia, thus fostering people-to-people ties and promoting knowledge sharing.

The Relevance of the Quad in International Relations:

The Quad's relevance in the current geopolitical climate cannot be understated. As global tensions rise and power dynamics shift, the Quad stands as a significant alliance that champions the rule of law, democratic values, and the peaceful resolution of disputes. It provides a critical counterbalance to authoritarian tendencies, especially in the Indo-Pacific, where China's actions threaten to destabilize the region.

The Quad's importance also lies in its non-military aspects. By addressing a range of issues, from maritime security and climate change to health and technology, the Quad presents itself as a versatile grouping capable of addressing multifaceted global challenges. This adaptability ensures that the Quad remains relevant and resilient in the face of evolving global dynamics.
