NEWS : Assam Government to Implement Key Recommendations of Clause 6 Committee, Constitutional Amendments Pending

WHAT'S IN THE NEWS?

The Assam government has initiated the implementation of 52 recommendations from the Clause 6 Committee of the Assam Accord, while deferring key provisions requiring constitutional amendments.

Assam Accord

- **Signed:** 1985 between the Centre, Assam government, and All Assam Student Union (AASU) after the 1979-85 Assam Movement.
- Cut-off Date: March 24, 1971 anyone who came to Assam before this is an Indian citizen; those after are considered foreigners.
- **Department:** "Implementation of Assam Accord Department" established in 1986 to oversee the Accord's provisions.

Clause 6 of the Accord

- Objective: Protect the cultural, social, and linguistic identity of Assamese people.
- **Issue:** Proper implementation of these safeguards has faced delays.

Biplab Sarma Committee (2019)

- Task: Recommend measures to implement Clause 6.
- Report (2020): Defined "Assamese people" and proposed job reservations, political representation, and land/language protections.

Assam Government's Response

- Action: 52 out of 67 recommendations will be implemented, focusing on land, language, and cultural preservation.
- **Pending:** 15 recommendations requiring constitutional amendments (e.g., political representation, job reservations) need discussions with the Centre.

Key Recommendations for Implementation



- 1. Land Rights: Only Assamese people can own land in certain areas.
- 2. Language Protection: Continue Assamese as the official language, with exceptions for local languages.
- 3. Cultural Heritage: Support for neo-Vaishnavite monasteries and district-level cultural complexes.

Pending Recommendations

• Political Representation: 80-100% seat reservations in Parliament and state assembly.

SINCE 2006

• Inner Line Permit: Proposal for stricter migration controls for Assam.

Future Outlook

• **Phased Approach:** Assam government progressing with its jurisdictional recommendations; contentious issues await central government cooperation.
