India and other countries seeking reform of the UN Security Council met in various formats along the fringes of the 79th session of the UN General Assembly, highlighting the urgent need for comprehensive change.

G4 Nations

- **Members:** India, Brazil, Germany, Japan
- **Purpose:** Advocate for United Nations Security Council (UNSC) reforms
- **Goal:** Secure permanent UNSC seats for its members



- **Advocacy:** Push for greater representation of developing countries
- **Relevance:** Aims to address global challenges and improve UNSC effectiveness

L69 Group

- **Members:** Developing countries from Asia, Africa, Latin America, and the Caribbean
- **Objective:** Advocate for comprehensive UNSC reforms
- **Focus:** Push for better representation of the Global South
- **Significance:** Strengthen the role of developing nations in global peace and security

C-10 Group

- **Members:** Ten African Union member countries (Committee of Ten African Heads of State)
- **Focus:** Advocate for Africa's representation in UNSC reforms
