WHAT'S IN THE NEWS?

The new electric mobility promotion scheme aims to reduce fossil fuel dependency and improve air quality by supporting the adoption of electric 2-wheelers, 3-wheelers, and buses, with a ₹10,900 crore budget. It replaces the FAME II scheme and runs from October 2024 to March 2026.

Objective:

• To promote electric mobility in India, reduce dependence on fossil fuels, and improve air quality.

Focus Areas:

- Faster adoption of electric vehicles (EVs): Incentives provided for electric 2-wheelers (e-2Ws), 3-wheelers (e-3Ws), and buses.
- Charging Infrastructure: Support for the establishment of public EV charging stations across India.
- EV Manufacturing Ecosystem: Development of a robust EV manufacturing ecosystem to increase domestic production.

Financial Outlay:

• The scheme has an allocated budget of ₹10,900 crore.

Duration:

• The scheme will run from 1st October 2024 to 31st March 2026.


Incentives:

- Subsidies for electric vehicles: Financial support for purchasing electric 2-wheelers, 3-wheelers, and buses.
- **Charging Infrastructure Subsidies**: Financial incentives for setting up public EV charging stations to make EV adoption more feasible.
