WHAT'S IN THE NEWS?

The MSE-SPICE scheme fosters Circular Economy adoption in MSMEs by promoting resource reduction, reuse, and recycling across 11 sectors. It supports sustainable practices with a Rs. 472.5 crore budget allocation.

MSE-SPICE Scheme:

- **Objective:** Promotes the adoption of Circular Economy (CE) solutions in over 3400 Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) in India.
- Focus Areas: Aims at reducing, reusing, and recycling resources to enhance sustainability in the MSME sector.
- Target Sectors: Includes 11 sectors: plastic, rubber, e-waste, municipal waste, compressed bio-gas, lithium-ion batteries, end-of-life vehicles, ferrous and non-ferrous scrap metal, solar panels, gypsum, and hazardous industrial waste.
- **Budget:** The scheme has an allocation of Rs. 472.5 crore.
- Expenditure: As of December 12, 2024, Rs. 1.31 crore has been spent under the scheme.
- Goal: Encourages sustainable practices through waste reprocessing and resource recirculation in MSMEs.
