WHAT'S IN THE NEWS?

The Golden-headed Cisticola was recently spotted in Mathikettan Shola National Park, Kerala, highlighting the park's rich biodiversity and unique shola ecosystem. This bird, typically found in grasslands of Asia and Australia, is an important species for ecological monitoring.

1. Mathikettan Shola National Park: A Unique Ecosystem Location & Importance

- Rivers: Uchillkuthi Puzha, Mathikettan Puzha, Njandar (tributaries of Panniyar).
- Major Tribal Group: Muthavan Tribe (indigenous to the region).



2. Golden-headed Cisticola: A Rare Sight in India General Characteristics

• Also known as the **Bright-capped Cisticola**.

- Omnivorous diet, primarily feeding on insects and small slugs.
- Recognizable by its distinctive call.

Habitat & Distribution

- Typically found in **grasslands** of **mountainous regions**.
- Global Distribution: Found in Australia and several Asian countries.
- Distribution in India: Previously spotted in Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, and Kerala.

Conservation Status

- IUCN Status: Least Concern (LC).
- Despite **low immediate threats**, habitat degradation in **shola grasslands** can impact its population.

3. Significance of the Sighting

- Biodiversity Indicator: Presence in Mathikettan Shola suggests rich grassland biodiversity.
- Conservation Implications: Highlights the need for protection of shola ecosystems.
