# What is the VNR Report?

- Presented by the Vice Chairman of NITI Aayog at the Ministerial Segment of the HLPF on Sustainable Development.
- The report outlines India's progress, innovations, and challenges in achieving the 17 Sustainable Development Goals under the 2030 Agenda.

## **Key Highlights of India's Progress on SDGs**

### **Poverty Alleviation**

- **Around 248 million people** have exited **Multidimensional Poverty** (MPI) between 2013–14 and 2022–23.
- Reflects success in **basic services access**, health, education, and living standards.

### **Food Security**

- PM Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana ensured:
  - Free ration distribution to **800 million people**.
  - Continued nutritional support even during crises like COVID-19.

#### **Health and Nutrition**

- POSHAN Abhiyaan:
  - Focused on improving maternal and child nutrition.
  - Integration of real-time monitoring systems via ICDS-Common Application Software (CAS).

### • Ayushman Bharat:

• Covers **500 million people** with free health insurance.

• Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) and PM-JAY expanding access to quality healthcare.

# **Clean Energy Transition**

- National Green Hydrogen Mission: Targeting low-carbon future through green hydrogen development.
- **PM-KUSUM**: Solarizing agricultural pumps to reduce diesel usage and promote renewable energy.
- PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana: Promoting rooftop solar installations in households.

### **Innovation and Startups**

- India has become the 3rd largest startup ecosystem globally.
- Strong government push via **Startup India**, **Digital India**, and **Atal Innovation Mission**.

# **Infrastructure Development**

- PM Gati Shakti: Integrated infrastructure planning using GIS tools and coordination between ministries.
- Make in India: Boosts manufacturing and employment.

National Industrial Corridor Development Programme: Creating next-gen industrial hubs.

### **Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI)**

- India is a **global leader in DPI** built around the **JAM Trinity**:
  - Jan Dhan (banking),
  - Aadhaar (identity),
  - Mobile (connectivity).
- Ensures inclusive, efficient, and transparent service delivery.

### **Index-Based Monitoring & Data-Driven Governance**

- **SDG India Index**: Developed by NITI Aayog to measure state-wise progress.
- Northeastern Region District SDG Index: Special focus on regional disparities.
- National MPI Index: Assesses deprivation across three dimensions—health, education, and standard of living.

### **Localisation & Last-Mile Delivery**

- Aspirational Districts Programme (ADP):
  - Targets 112 underdeveloped districts.

- Improves health, nutrition, education, agriculture, and basic infrastructure.
- Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP):
  - Extends the model to 500 blocks, enabling grassroots development and policy saturation.

## **About Voluntary National Reviews (VNRs)**

- Purpose: Track the implementation of SDGs at national and sub-national levels.
- Nature: Voluntary, inclusive, country-led, and transparent.
- Presentation: Annually at the High-Level Political Forum (HLPF) in July in New York.

#### **Objectives of VNRs**

- Share success stories, policy innovations, and implementation challenges.
- Strengthen governance, institutional frameworks, and coordination.
- Mobilize multi-stakeholder partnerships (governments, civil society, private sector).
- Foster accountability, peer learning, and knowledge exchange.

# High-Level Political Forum (HLPF) on Sustainable Development

- Function: Central global platform for reviewing SDG progress.
- Organised By: UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC).
- Headquarters: New York, USA.

### **Meeting Structure**

- Held annually under ECOSOC.
- Every four years at the level of Heads of State/Government under the UN General Assembly.

## **Key Features**

- Promotes a **rights-based and inclusive discourse** on development.
- Encourages multi-stakeholder participation and peer review among countries.
