1. Russian President Vladimir Putin has announced that his country's new type of missile, the 'oreshnik', which can travel at 10 times the speed of sound, will be deployed in neighboring Belarus.
2. El Salvador's Parliament has approved a constitutional amendment that would extend the President's term in office indefinitely.
3. The South African Government has begun implanting Radioactive Isotopes into the horns of rhinos to prevent them from being poached.
4. Protests have erupted in Nigeria against the end of fuel subsidies, where inflation is at 34 percent.
5. IPS officer, Sonali Mishra took charge as the first woman Director General (DG) of the Railway Protection Force (RPF), making her the first woman officer to head the force in its 143-year history.
6. DAP (Diammonium Phosphate) is the second most demanded fertilizer in India after urea. China is the world leader in the supply of this fertilizer. India is largely dependent on Chinese imports for its fertilizer needs. In this context, Indian imports have declined due to the China's additional restrictions on the export of fertilizers, including DAP. Ammonium Phosphate Sulfate (APS) fertilizer can be used as an alternative to DAP. Although APS provides nitrogen, phosphorus, and sulfur, the amount of phosphorus is low (20 percent). DAP contains 40 percent phosphorus.
7. Jagdeep Dhankhar, the India's 14th Vice-President, resigned from his post with two more years left to his term.
8. World Breastfeeding Week is celebrated annually from August 1 to August 7.
9. The 'Level Up' program is being implemented in Government schools to develop basic English language skills. The School Education Department is implementing a voluntary program called 'Level Up' to improve the basic English language skills of students from grades 6 to 8 in government schools, including listening, reading, speaking and writing.
10. Chief Minister M.K. Stalin laid the foundation stone for a mini tidal park in Tiruvannamalai that will create 600 new jobs.
11. Ayushman Bharat is the health insurance scheme of the Government of India.
